Family Mass Attendance Agreement

When you presented your child for Baptism, the priest read from the Rite of Baptism: “you are accepting the responsibility of training him (her) in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring him (her) up to keep God’s commandments as Christ taught us.”

I understand that when I do not take my children to Mass, I am denying them the opportunity to praise God, denying them the opportunity to hear the Word of God, denying them participation in the holy sacrifice of the Mass, and denying them the divine grace from receiving the Most Holy Eucharist (for those of age) and from being in the presence of God.

I understand that attending Mass is a *willing* sign of our love for God and for the most perfect sacrifice of Jesus Christ, and not just something we do because the Catholic Church says we have to.

I understand that divine grace is necessary for the nourishment of our soul, just as food is necessary for the nourishment of our physical body.

I understand that taking my children to Mass is the primary and ordinary means by which they receive the free gift of God’s grace (divine life). I further understand that not attending Mass on a regular basis hinders the spiritual growth of my children and makes it harder for them to grasp what we are teaching them in CCD class.

I understand that participating in Mass **every Sunday** is a serious obligation for every Catholic.

Therefore, I understand that attending Mass is an integral part of my child’s religious formation and that ***my child’s continued enrollment in St. John’s religious education program is contingent upon regular Mass attendance.*** I understand that Mass attendance will be determined by having my child’s Mass card stamped after each Mass. (If you attend Mass at another church, you must bring a bulletin from that parish to your child’s CCD teacher.)

I promise before God to fulfill my responsibilities as a Catholic parent by practicing the Catholic Faith with my child. I understand “practicing the faith” to include attending weekly Sunday Mass at St. John the Evangelist and otherwise living my life in accord with the teachings of Jesus Christ.
