

Frequently Asked Questions

Who Can Register?

- You must be a Parent or the Legal Guardian (bring guardianship papers) to register children.
- You must be an active registered parishioner of St. John's currently receiving envelopes. You must reside within the parish boundaries in order to register with the church.

What Do I Need to Bring to Registration?

- New registrations must present an original baptismal certificate at registration, even if baptized at St. John's (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- Returning Registrations must present an original baptismal certificate at registration, even if baptized at St. John's (NO EXCEPTIONS), **ONLY IF your student was not enrolled in 2009-10 or 2008-09.**
- New Registrations must provide verification of First Communion and any prior Religious Education (you must bring a letter from your previous parish verifying enrollment dates, grade levels enrolled, and number of classes absent for each year enrolled.) as well as a copy of the First Communion Certificate.
- Payment in full or make PRIOR arrangements with the DRE if you need to make payment arrangements

When Is Registration?

Sunday August 15th 1:30 — 3:30 p.m. (in the Parish Hall)

August 17 through August 31

- NO Registration on Mondays
- Tuesdays from 10:00 a.m.—7:00 p.m. in the parish office
- Wednesday—Friday from 10:00 a.m.—2:00 p.m. in the parish office

Preferred class times are available on a first-come-first-served basis at registration.

How Much Does it Cost?

Regular Tuition

\$75 Kindergarten
\$145 One child (1st grade through Confirmation II)
\$280 Two or more (Kindergarten – Confirmation II)
\$80 Confirmation Immediate Preparation
\$50 Additional fee for each First Communion

Payment is due in full at registration. Anyone who needs to make payment arrangements or who cannot afford to pay the tuition should contact the Director of Religious Education **prior to registration.**

What if My Child Needs First Communion or Confirmation?

- Preparation for Confirmation requires two years of **pre-requisite** formation beginning in the 7th grade. Confirmation is normally received in the 9th grade after 2 years of prior study.
- Preparation for First Communion requires one year of **pre-requisite** formation beginning in 1st grade. First Communion is normally received at the end of 2nd grade.
