

Extra Ordinary Eucharistic Minister Positions

CHOIR – stand at the far left when you go to the sanctuary

- . if the celebrant hands the chalice to you to distribute, receive the Precious Blood and then hand the chalice to the EM next to you so that you can go directly to the choir after the celebrant hands a ciborium to you
- . when finished, check to see if any stations need help (**only 2 ministers should be at any station**) - if not, return to the sanctuary

LEFT SIDE (*looking **OUT** from the altar*)

L1 – stand **close** to the steps

L2 – stand **close** to the pew to allow for good traffic flow

CF – stand in the middle until the celebrant joins you – then move to the side

RIGHT SIDE (*looking **OUT** from the altar*)

R1 – stand **close** to the steps

R2 – stand **close** to the pew to allow for good traffic flow

R3 – stand close to the steps & then go to R2 if no one is there – if R2 is taken, check to see if any stations need help (**only 2 ministers should be at any station**) – if not, return to the sanctuary

ROAMER – go down the inner left side aisle to the back center of the church, check for any handicapped people, give the Eucharist to the first rows and then go to the back, the center aisle and then to the rest of the back (see diagram – an usher should point out the people to receive the Eucharist)

CRY ROOM – go down the right side aisle near the half-wall and check for any handicapped people, give the Eucharist to the first rows, then stand in the front center of the cry room close to the window. (The usher may direct you to other handicapped people before you enter the cry room.)

When finished, check to see:

1. if Fr. Is alone, stand **NEXT** to him in front of the line of people coming forward (Father will move over). **There should be only 2 people in the very front.**
 - . if there are 2 ministers in the CF and the lines are long, stand **NEXT to the pew** to allow for good traffic flow (see **X** on diagram)
2. if any other stations need help (**only 2 ministers should be at any station**) – if not return to the sanctuary and wait for Fr. to return, **then hand your ciborium to the celebrant/deacon and move away.**
